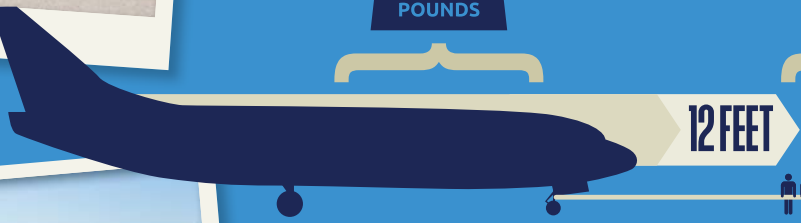




HOW FAST CAN YOU PULL AN AIRPLANE?
